News Release from Arabic Bible Outreach Ministries

August 16, 2006

Dear Brethren,

The situation in Lebanon is stabilizing and people are returning back to their homes in the South of Lebanon trying to restore their livelihood and assess their loss.

An update on the believers who were stuck in the south...

- The Lord has protected the Pastor and the twenty families who were hiding in the Church during the heavy bombardment. Less than a week ago, the Israeli troops entered the village and permitted more than 600 cars to leave that village (mostly traditional Christians). Several families from that church went with the convoy and the rest stayed with Pastor Najib. However, for some unknown reason, an Israeli Drone bombed the convoy as it was heading to the Bekaa valley even though they were permitted to leave by the Israeli army. Nine people were killed and many were wounded. We heard that one of the Brethren was among the killed and 4 of the brethren were wounded. We are trying to confirm this report and we will keep you updated.
- In the meantime, we urgently need to ask all of you to keep praying for the believers in Lebanon specially those who were affected from the month long conflict.
- Many thanks to all of you who sent love gifts to our ministry to be channeled for the help and support of the believers in Lebanon. We are planning to send the money received next week and by God's grace, we trust it will be used for His glory.

Prayer Requests:

- For peace to be asserted permanently in that region and that Hezbollah will disarm and allows the Lebanese Government to control all of Lebanon.
- For much fruit among Shiites Muslims who heard the Gospel by word of mouth and through the lives of believers
- Of course no real peace without the Gospel of our Lord - Pray that the Church in the USA be more sensitive to the field of Islam. 1.3 Billion Muslims still without the Gospel and only the Gospel of Christ can defeat terror.
- For the believers in Lebanon -- pray for much strength, wisdom and courage as they labor for our Lord.
